

RESOLUTION NO. 92

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR A LIVABLE DELAWARE GRANT

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Town of Dewey Beach to promote the growth and development in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and property owners and to encourage the preservation of the unique character of the Town, the efficient provision of municipal services to all residents and businesses, and the protection of the quality of life in Town , AND

WHEREAS, the Town adopted a Comprehensive Land Use Plan in July 2007 in accordance with Title 22 of the Delaware Code, AND

WHEREAS, the Town wishes to initiate revisions to the current Zoning Code, AND

WHEREAS, grant funding from the State of Delaware is available to assist towns to ensure that their Codes are in compliance with their Comprehensive land Use Plans through the limited funding pool of the Livable Delaware Fund Account;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Commissioners of Dewey Beach

Section 1. A grant application requesting \$10,000.00 from the limited funding pool of the Livable Delaware Fund Account shall be submitted to the Office of State Planning.

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by a majority of all members elected to the Town Commissioner of Dewey Beach.
