

RESOLUTION

OF

THE TOWN OF DEWEY BEACH


WHEREAS, plans are under way by Delaware Department of Transportation of the State of Delaware to perform work on Highway 1 in the Town of Dewey Beach; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid planned work will affect the quality of life in the Town of Dewey Beach and will impact on the welfare of the inhabitants and residents of the Town of Dewey Beach; and

WHEREAS, it is the considered opinion of the Commissioners of the Town of Dewey Beach that increased traffic flow, higher speed, fewer cross-overs and pedestrian crossing lights at designated cross-overs only, together with widening of the roadway will be detrimental to the Town of Dewey Beach, its inhabitants and its way of life;

NOW, WHEREFORE, the Commissioners of the Town of Dewey Beach hereby resolve that all efforts be made to insure that the alleged improvements to Highway 1 through the Town of Dewey Beach be deferred until alternate routes to the South are developed and that no effort be made to increase traffic flow through the Town of Dewey Beach.
