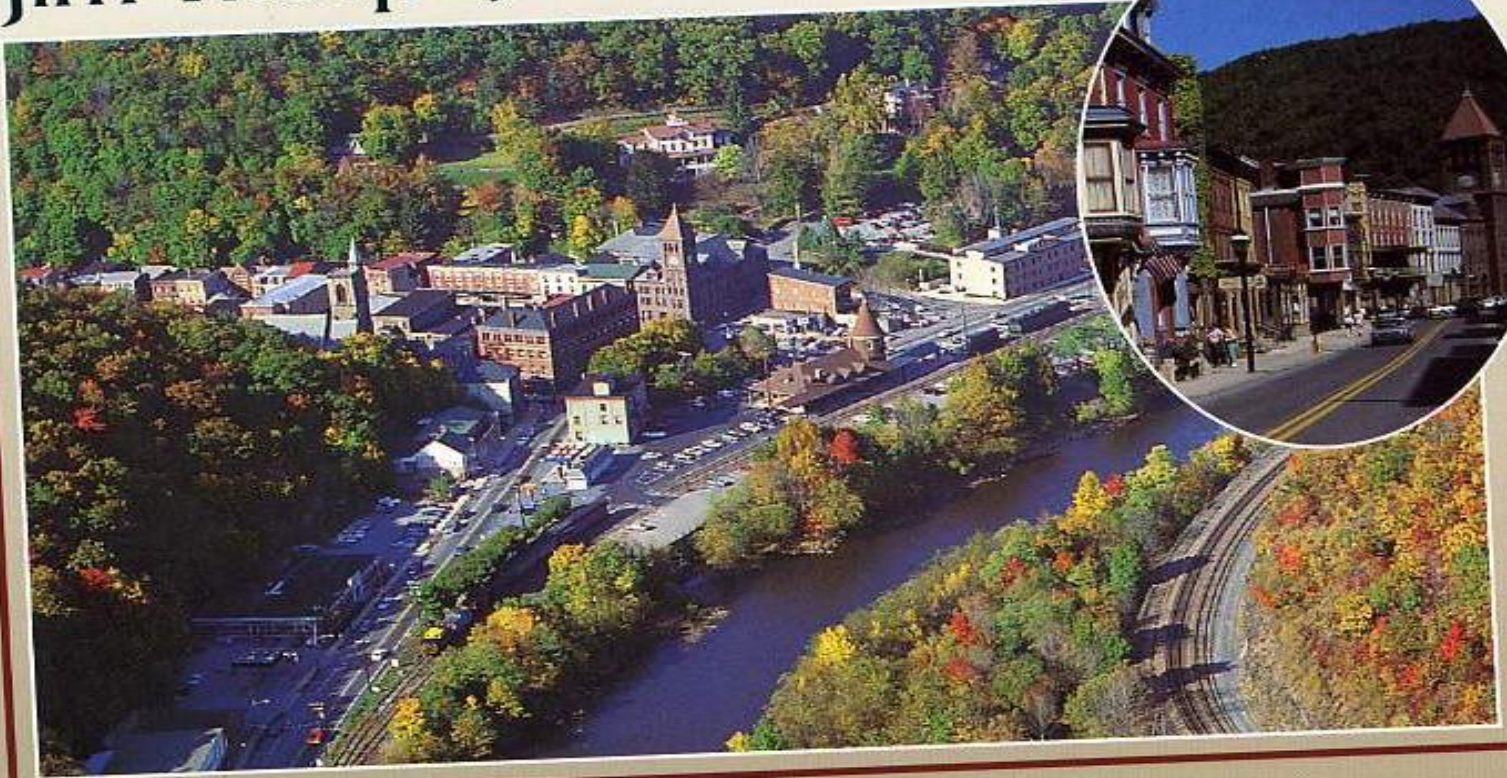


Jim Thorpe, PA

THE PACE WILL BE RELAXED: IT WOULD BE A SHAME TO RUSH THROUGH IT, THERE IS SO MUCH TO SEE.

WE'LL TOUR THIS AMAZING PLACE BRIEFLY ON FOOT, ONCE THE RICHEST CITY IN THE USA. WE'LL LEARN ABOUT ITS ORIGINS, WHAT 'MAUCH CHUNK' MEANS AND HOW IT BECAME 'JIM THORPE'. WE WILL HAVE THE OPTION TO SPEND THE NIGHT.

THE ROADS UP AND BACK ARE LIGHTLY TRAVELLED AND PASS THROUGH SOME INTERESTING REGIONS WHERE COAL WAS ONCE KING. WE'LL STOP AT SEVERAL POINTS OF INTEREST. ECONOMICALLY DEPRESSED THESE DAYS, THE MOUNTAINOUS COUNTRYSIDE STILL PROVIDES ENDLESS ENTERTAINMENT FOR MOTORCYCLE TRAVEL.

AFTER LUNCH WE'LL TURN BACK SOUTH AND ENJOY A CELEBRATORY MEAL AT THE END OF A LONG DAY, HAVING COVERED 200-250 MILES ALL TOLD. A FANTASTIC WAY TO EXPERIENCE CLASSIC MOTORCYCLING AT ITS VERY BEST.
