

THE KINZUA BRIDGE/COUMBUS DAY TOUR: OCTOBER 11, 12, 13, 14
(Friday, Saturday, Sunday, Monday)

Four 150-mile days will bring us directly northwest as we slice across the Endless Mountains of Central Pennsylvania. We'll stop for the first night at the first cheap motel we find just past the 150 mile mark. Day two is only slightly longer, but much more remote, ending up in Smethport, where the tiny motel will instantly transport you back to the 70's. Sunday morning we wake up early and ride about 20 miles to this incredible sight.....

....300 feet tall and over 2,000 feet long. It was built in 1882 and collapsed in a tornado in 2003. You can walk out to the viewing platform on the end, and the view includes the wreckage and the fall foliage in season. It is spectacular!

But wait, there's more.... in addition to 4 days of riding on super vintage bikes, through some of the most beautiful countryside anywhere (the west bank of the Susquehanna River is stupendous at this time of the year, and the roads are to die for) our return route skirts York, PA, making a stop for the Harley Davidson Factory Tour an easy add on. You cannot pack anything more into 4 days. I know it would do you good!
