

Town of Dewey Beach 2015 License Fees

Licenses shall be required for the following trades, businesses and occupations in the Town and the license fee shall be as set forth beside the names of said trades, businesses and occupations:

- 1) Residential Property Rental: \$142.00 base fees plus \$11.00 for each bedroom over two.
- 2) Motel or hotel: \$382.00 base fee plus \$22.00 per room.
- 3) Commercial Property Rental: \$164.00 per unit with gross square footage up to 1,000 sq. ft.; \$218.00 per unit with gross square footage greater than 1,000 sq. ft. and not in excess of 2,000 sq. ft.; \$327.00 per unit with gross square footage greater than 2,000 sq. ft.
- 4) Real estate broker: \$382.00.
- 5) Real estate agent: \$109.00.
- 6) ABCC licensed establishments and non-ABCC licensed establishments, including conforming or non-conforming restaurants, eateries, bars and/or taverns serving alcoholic beverages or not: \$273.00 base fee plus \$6.00 per person based on the occupancy limit as determined and posted by the State of Delaware Fire Marshall's office. This would include any decks and outdoor seating. For those facilities that do not have Fire Marshall Rated Capacity, we will use existing seating capacity and this would also include any decks and outdoor seating.
- 7) Package store: \$2180.00.
- 8) Convention center: \$2180.00
- 9) Taxi or limousine company: \$109.00 base fee plus \$109.00 per company vehicle licensed to pick passengers up in Dewey Beach.
- 10) Pedi-cab company: \$109.00 base fee plus \$28 per pedi cab licensed to pick passengers up in Dewey Beach.
- 11) Landscaping business: \$382.00.
- 12) Vending machine: \$28.00 per vending machine.
- 13) Small In-Town business (other than as listed in Nos. 1 – 12 above): \$273.00
- 14) Large In-Town business (other than as listed in Nos. 1 – 12 above): \$382.00
- 15) Small Out-of-Town business (other than as listed in Nos. 1 – 12 above): \$109.00
- 16) Large Out-of-Town business (other than as listed in Nos. 1 – 12 above): \$382.00

For the purposes of determining the proper business license fee:

- A "small" business is defined as one having four (4) or fewer employees or occupying a gross square footage of no more than 1,000 sq. ft.;
- A "large" business is defined as one having five (5) or more employees or occupying a gross square footage in excess of 1,000 sq. ft.
