SYNOPSIS OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE TOWN OF DEWEY BEACH- SUMMER SEASON (MAY 15th- SEPTEMBER 15th):

- No alcoholic beverages are allowed in public, including the beach.
- Smoking is prohibited in town parks AND on the beach and beach dunes.
- The beach is open from 5:30A.M. –1A.M.
- Surf fishing is permitted on the beach! You
 must ensure that you are not within 100 feet of
 bathers if you are fishing between the hours of
 10:00A.M. and 5:00P.M.
- No private vehicles are allowed on the beach.
 Glass bottles and containers are prohibited on the beach.
- No commercial activity is allowed on the beach or public streets unless approved by the Town.
- Please respect Dewey Beach and help us to keep it beautiful! Littering is subject to fines, and is prohibited within town limits AND on the beach.
- Sporting activities on the beach are limited between the hours of 11A.M.—3P.M. Please check with a lifeguard prior to engaging in sporting activities.
- For your safety and the safety of fellow beachgoers, launching and swimming to and from boats is prohibited.
- Occupancy Limits- are 2 (two) persons per bedroom, plus a maximum of 2 (two) additional persons allowed in a general living area.
- · Sleeping in vehicles is prohibited.

FEES:

Seasonal- \$200.00 Weekly (any 7 consecutive days)- \$55.00 One Day (Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday)- \$10.00 One Day (Thursday/ Friday/Saturday/Sunday)- \$15.00 Weekend (Friday/Saturday/Sunday)- \$35.00

DEWEY BEACH PROPERTY OWNERS who have paid their Beach Replenishment Tax may purchase up to a maximum of 2 (two) Seasonal Parking Permits for \$150.00 each.

SEASONAL PARKING PERMITS MAY BE PURCHASED in person, by sending a check to Town Hall, or via credit card over the phone.

LOST OR STOLEN Seasonal Parking Permits may be replaced 1 (one) time at half of the original cost ONCE the Police Department is notified AND a report is filed.

PARKING PERMITS ARE NOT VALID for use at Parking Meter spots.

Dewey Beach Parking Permits are ONLY valid in the Town of Dewey Beach.

HANDICAP Parking tags are valid to use as a parking permit at all permit parking AND parking meter spots, but MUST be visibly displayed.

HANDICAP BEACH WHEEL CHAIRS-

Handicap Beach Wheel Chairs are available from the Dewey Beach lifeguards. To reserve a chair between the dates of May 15th – September 15th, please call the Lifesaving Station at (302) 227-6365.

TRASH and RECYCLING PICK-UP-

For Monday morning trash and recycling pick-up: trash and recycling receptacles can be placed on the town public right-of-way after 12:00 P.M. Sunday, and must be removed and placed on private (your) property by 5:00 P.M. on Monday. For Friday morning trash and recycling pick-up: trash and recycling receptacles can be placed on the town public right-of-way after 5:00 P.M. Thursday, and must be removed and placed on private (your) property by 8:00 P.M. Friday.

curfew for minors. No minor shall remain in or upon any public place between the hours of 11P.M.-5A.M. of the following day, except on Fridays and Saturdays when curfew hours shall be from 12A.M. (midnight) – 5A.M.

DISORDERLY HOUSES- are prohibited.
Convictions may lead to a tenant's eviction, and the property owner could be subject to the loss of their rental license. To report a disorderly house or noise emanating from a commercial establishment, call the Dewey Beach Police Department: (302) 227-1110.

DOGS- are welcome! Dogs must be licensed with the town, and are not allowed on the beach between the hours of 9:30A.M.-5:30P.M. from May 15th - September 15th. Owners MUST clean up after their dog. Dog licenses may be purchased at Town Hall Monday – Friday 9A.M. - 5P.M.

BONFIRES- are permitted on the beach! To obtain a permit you must pay \$30.00 for the permit and \$40.00 (cash only) security deposit. The \$40.00 cash deposit is refundable upon cleaning up the fire and all remnants, the night of the fire. The deposit can be picked up at Town Hall after 10A.M. the following day.
