

RESOLUTION NO. 14

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of the Town of Dewey Beach that pursuant to the Town Charter, it is hereby proposed to the property owners and residents of both the Town and the "Territory" proposed to be annexed that the Town of Dewey Beach proposes to annex certain territories which adjoin its limits and territory.


The description of the proposed area to be annexed is:

ALL that lot, piece and parcel of land lying and being in Lewes and Rehoboth Hundred, Sussex County, Delaware, lying adjacent to the corporate limits of the Town of Dewey Beach and extending 500 feet Westerly into the waters of the Rehoboth Bay, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southerly boundary of the Town of Dewey Beach and the mean high water mark of the Rehoboth Bay; thence Westerly a distance of 500 feet to a point in the Rehoboth Bay; thence Northerly with the meanderings of line 500 feet Westerly from the mean high water mark of the Rehoboth Bay to a point 500 feet from the present intersection of the Westerly Town boundary and the Rehoboth Bay; thence proceeding another 500 feet to the present intersection of the Westerly Town boundary and the Rehoboth Bay; thence Southerly and with the meanderings of the Rehoboth Bay shoreline to the point and place of beginning, said contents be what they may.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that a public hearing on the subject of the proposed annexation shall be held on September 12, 1987 at the Dewey Beach Town Hall at 11:00 a.m. following the regular Town meeting.
