
Be it resolved by the Commissioners of the Town of Dewey Beach, Sussex County, Delaware that at the March 11, 1995 Dewey Beach Town Council Meeting the Commissioners voted to recommend that Title 23, Section 2212 (i) of the Delaware Code relating to navigation and the waters, entitled "Boating Safety", as amended, be amended to revise the distance that personal watercraft must keep from wharfs, piers, docks, etc.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Delaware (two-thirds of all members elected to each house thereof concurring therein):

Section 1. Subsection (i) of Section 2212 of Chapter 22, Section 212, of Title 23 Delaware Code, as amended, is amended by striking the words "100 feet" and substituting in lieu thereof the words "300 feet".

This Amendment is intended to increase the required distance that any person operating a personal watercraft at any speed greater than headway speed must be kept from all wharfs, piers, docks, boat launching areas, pilings, bridge structures or abutments, moored, drifting or anchored vessels, all non-motorized vessels and any shoreline, from 100 feet to 300 feet.
