

RESOLUTION #62

BE IT RESOLVED, on this 12th Day of October, 1996, that the Town of Dewey Beach has reached a transportation crisis with regard to summer traffic congestion and parking availability. We, the Dewey Beach Commissioners, feel fortunate to have access to DRT, an advanced public transportation system, but feel the system is underutilized. We feel that part of the reason is that there is no DRT route between Rehoboth Beach and Dewey Beach. A direct Rehoboth-Dewey loop, operated by DRT, would greatly enhance the system and increase use by local residents, visitors and employees of local businesses, thus relieving traffic and parking problems and allow safe, easy access between the two resorts. By making the transportation system easy to use, we may reach a point where visitors leave their cars at the Park & Ride for their entire stay.
