

**Charter and Code Review Ad Hoc Committee Meeting  
Minutes for Meeting held Saturday, April 7, 2018 at 10:00am**

**Convene Meeting**

Committee Chair, David King called the meeting to order at 10:03am.

Roll call was taken with Elaine Bole, Julie Johnson, David King, Marcia Schieck and Bill Galbraith being present.

Regarding the minutes from March 10, Julie Johnson indicated that there was a correction adding Bill Galbraith's name as the person who made the motion to adopt the previous minutes. A motion to approve the minutes with that correction from the March 10 meeting was made by Elaine Bole and seconded by Marsha Schieck. All other members approved the adoption of the minutes with the correction.

**Discussion and possible votes on draft amendments to all Section of the Town Charter for recommendation to the Town Council**

At 10:05 David King started the discussion regarding what the structure of the form of government of the Town should be.

At 10:23 David King started the discussion of the red lined Charter document created to facilitate discussion regarding changes to the Charter previously discussed by the committee.

**Final Comments from the public, and from CCR Committee Members**

At 12:29, public comment was sought with Gary Talley bringing up the possibility of decertifying the Town of Dewey so all functions (police, life guards, etc.) be absorbed by Sussex County and the State so that the need for Charter changes would be moot. The committee indicated that this body was not the correct one to bring this up to and the correct forum would be to bring it up as a public comment in a Town meeting.
