Can we pet the horses?

No petting. Thank-you.

Can we get our pictures taken with the horses?

Yes! But you must be at a 4-5 foot distance. There will be three opportunities for “visiting” with the Budweiser and the horses.

5:00 - 6:00 Saulsbury Street (staging)

6:00 Starboard Parking Lot (pre party)

7:00- 7:45 Rudder/Lighthouse Circle Dickinson Street and the Bay

8:00-8:45 Ques Pasa Van Dyke Street (un-hitching)

What time does the parade begin?

Parade begins at 6:30.

Is there a rain date?

No, but there could be a delay or modification in schedule. Please check our Facebook page or website

Are there any activities beforehand?

Yes, the horses will hitch and stage on Salisbury Street at 5:00. They will move to to the Starboard Parking lot for a pre-party. The public is welcome to view the staging.

What is the parade route?

Parade starts at Saulsbury Street at 6:30.

It will continue South along Route One.

It will make a right turn up Dickinson to the Circle, back to Rt. One and continue to Van Dyke Street.

The Clydesdales are at the **end of the parade**. They will stop at the Dickinson Street Circle at 7:00 for an hour, then continue to Van Dyke Street and the bay where they will be from 8:00 - 8:45. The Clydesdales will be unhitched at Van Dyke and return to the Budweiser Trailers.

Where can I park in Dewey?

Parking meters and permits are FREE from 5 pm to 11 pm.

Is there any other transportation?

Jolly Trolley will be running from Dewey to Rehoboth. Uber cars and Taxis are running too.

We suggest going to the bayside beach at Dickinson at the Lighthouse/Rudder or the bayside beach at Que Pasa. There will be kids activities at Que Pasa Beach on Van Dyke.

Where is the best spot to view the parade?

Anywhere along Rt. One south of Salisbury Street. Parade can also be view from the east side of Route One. Standing in the median strip is strictly forbidden.

What streets will be closed/parking restrictions?

**Right lanes of Route One South closed 6:15-7:30p.m.Wednesday
Left lane will remain open.**

**Saulsbury Street (bayside) - no parking July 12, 2 a.m. to Wednesday July 12, 6:30 p.m.
Closed to traffic 4 to 6 p.m.**

**Swedes St. Bayside
5:30 to 6:45**

**Van Dyke Bayside
No parking in Center and Northside spots next to Hyatt 9:00 a.m. -9:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 12.
Closed to traffic...6:00 p.m. 9:00 p.m.**

**Dickinson- closed to traffic approximately 6:45 - 7:00 p.m.
Circle closed 5:30 pm until approximately 8:00pm**
