I. The initial meeting of the Dewey Beach Infrastructure Committee was held at 0930 hr on April 16, 2016 at the Dewey Beach Lifesaving Station. Attending were Chairman Jim Tyler, Phil Winkler, Marilyn Cannon and Marty Tarr. Absent was Paul Handley.

II. Phil Winkler was nominated and approved as Vice-Chairman/Secretary for the Committee. It was noted that Town Commissioner Gary Mauler, our liaison to the Town Commissioners, was not present.

III. We determined that the primary areas of interest for the committee are (in no particular order):

- Lighting
- Security cameras
- Drainage
- Speed Bumps
- Sidewalks

IV. We decided that the method of providing the town our recommendations for improvement would be by:

A. Preparing a problem statement of the current status of each area and why it might need improvement.

B. Each area would be researched to gather as much information as possible.

C. The gathered data will be analyzed and discussed and potential solutions offered.

D. One solution for each problem will be selected and suggested to the town for implementation.

E. Once implemented the area will be reexamined to see if the solution worked or some other action is needed.

V. Jim noted that the Center for Inland Bays would be hosting a meeting with DNREC at their office at Indian River Inlet on May 3rd at 1000 hrs. He noted that he would attend.

VI. It was noted that the Town Comprehensive Plan Committee would also be addressing infrastructure issues and that we could probably coordinate our research.

VII. Finally, we discussed how any of our recommendations might be funded. We discussed Dewey's lack of a property tax and that it relied on licensing fees and the accommodation tax for much of its revenue.

The meeting adjourned at 1015 hrs. The next meeting will be May 12, 2016, at 1 PM in the Marina View Community Room.
