Dear Mr. McQueen,

A sediment control and stormwater management plan approval has been extended for the above-referenced project. Please note that the timeframe for this plan is three years from the approval date and your plan will now expire on July 5, 2015. If for any reason construction does not begin within three years, the approved plan will be considered to have expired, and must be resubmitted to the District for a new review. In addition, if work is not completed within the three-year timeframe, the District must be contacted and a request for an extension submitted. Depending on regulation changes, a new plan may need to be submitted to ensure that all stormwater management facilities are constructed to the most recent standards.

Enclosed are the approved revised plan sheets which should be incorporated into the original approved plan and maintained onsite during construction.
