## Spring and Summer Day Camps Registration Open

Registration is now available for the Plainfield Parks & Recreation Spring and Summer Day Camps.

Campers will have the opportunity to create various crafts, work as a team in games, sports and recreation, and just have a fun time doing indoor and outdoor activities while making new friends. Spring camps will be available for two weeks, March 21 through March 25 (registration deadline March 6) and March 28 through April 1 (registration deadline March 13). In the summer Plainfield Parks & Recreation will host nine weeks of camps.

“Spring is just a few weeks away, and once the warmer weather sets in, everyone will be thinking about summer, so the time to sign up is now,” said Brian McLane, Recreation Program Supervisor, “We have a very short deadline for Spring Camps. The first one closes March 6. Our summer camps are very popular and will sell out quickly. We encourage parents to register as soon as possible in order to avoid being disappointed later. Kids especially enjoy being able to use the Splash Island indoor and outdoor water parks as a part of the camp activities. Plus they have access to all the amenities of our Recreation Center and to the other parks in our system as schedules and supervision allow.”

The nine weeks of Summer Camps start the week of May 30-June 3 and end the week of July 25-29. All are available for registration either through the online registration system on the Town’s website ([www.townofplainfield.com](http://www.townofplainfield.com) > Parks & Rec > Register Online for Activities) or by contacting the front desk of the Recreation and Aquatic Center.



“Our camps run from 8 in the morning until 5 in the evening,” McLane added. “But if parents need a little more time before and after the scheduled hours, a supervised play option is available at an additional cost. It can help working parents adjust the dropoff and pick-up times to better meet their personal schedules.”

### Heavy Trash Days: Save the Date!

## Sign Up Now for Summer Sewer Rates

Residents who tend to use a lot of water during the summer may want to take advantage of summer sewer rates which will be available for five months in the summer starting with the June meter read.

For a non-refundable \$50 application fee, residents may apply for the special rate at the Town Hall, 206 West Main Street. The application form is also available online at the Town's website under the Utility Billing department.

The special rate, an unmetered \$35.13/month, applies to single-family residential sewer service only. It does not apply to sewer service for any premises used wholly or in part as commercial, industrial, or multifamily (two units or more) property. For 2016, the summer sewer rate will begin with the June due July 15th billing and end with the October due November 15 billing.

Residents should sign up as soon as possible. The deadline is May 15. Those signing up after the deadline will pay a \$10 penalty. Summer sewer rates paid after May 15 will commence with the next bill cycle after the payment is received. Summer sewer rates are not retroactive.

"The goal of the program is to provide relief for single family residential customers who sprinkle their lawns," said Kent McPhail, a Town Council member who acts as the liaison between the Council and the Sewer Department.
