PARKING TIMES

The City of Bath provides free, unmetered parking to all on-street users or in municipal lots for two hours or less, unless otherwise signed. On-street parking is enforced 8am to 5pm, Monday through Saturday. Parking in permit lots is permitted after 6pm and on weekends.

FEES/FINES

BATH CITYBUS

The Bath CityBus leaves regularly from downtown and loops throughout the City. Each ride on the regular service is \$1. Schedules are available on CityofBath.com/CityBus or at City Hall.

DOWNTOWN PARKING PERMIT

A Downtown Parking Permit may be purchased at the cost of \$45 per month. Each permit is for a specific lot within the downtown. If interested, please contact the Bath Police Department. Please note that there may be a waiting list for permits.

PARKING BAN

Bath has a Winter Parking Ban from November 15 - March 15. There is no over-night parking on any City streets during this time.

PEDESTRIANS/BICYCLISTS

Bath is a pedestrian and bike-friendly city. Remember it is Maine law to stop for all pedestrians on cross-walks.
