CT-POST Certified Police Officers must meet POST Lateral Entry Requirements. Entry Level, Non-Certified Candidates must be 21 years of age and possess a high school diploma or GED. Both Certified and Non-Certified must pass written, oral, Cooper's Fitness Test, psychological, polygraph, and background investigation, must possess a valid CT Driver's License, and must be non-smokers. Salary for Certified Police Officers is \$68,712.78 to \$82,047.25. Salary for Non-Certified Candidates is \$52,854.02 to \$82,047.25. Both positions receive paid vacation, holiday, personal, sick, and bonus time, MERS Pension Plan, excellent benefits package. Four days on and two days off work schedule.
