- 5. Examples of ADA renovation projects completed; with an emphasis of ADA projects.
- 6. List of three professional and personal references relating to the housing and community development renovation projects, with an emphasis of ADA projects.
- 7. List and briefly explain successful Experience & Examples of completed projects working on ADA Projects.
- 8. Has the responding professional/company or individual[s] therein ever been suspended, or disbarred, or disciplined from any local, state, or federal governmental agency or entity? If yes please explain in detail. Failure to provide this background material the Mayor may terminate the Contract at their own discretion. Please note one minor violation does not exclude anyone; it depends on the severity, frequencies, and related topics.

Has the firm or any individual in your organization ever been placed on the Office of Inspector General (OIG) Exclusion listing, state DAS or DOH exclusion listing, or other type of governmental exclusion listing anywhere in the USA? [IV.] Architectural Qualifications/Services - RFQ Scope of Work

- Prepare AIA ADA drawings and specifications for the male and female bathrooms on the first and second floors of the Plymouth Town Hall. CT. Also produce the same to build a ADA ramp to gain access to the Town Council staging area in the bottom floor Community Room' where Public Meetings and Monthly Meetings are frequently held.
- AIA supervision of all construction/renovation related activities.
- Represent the Mayor and Town to attend various meetings and conferences with STEAP funding and related organizational entities.
- Write and prepare as the AIA for the related paperwork throughout the grant including Interim Status Reports, Close-Out documents, and related state, local, and possibly federal required Reports.
- <u>Coordinate with the Mayor</u> and other Town officials' architects, and other professionals to complete all required grant or ADA Plans paperwork. Examples but not limited to: ADA, structural, etc.
- Assist in procurement, selection, and cooperation process for licensed General Contractor bidding or construction cost estimation necessary for the financing application.
