*No plumber or other person shall make any connection to a public sewer or drain of the sewer authority without a permit.*

**Sewer Lateral Permit Fee** – shall consist of a standalone fee paid to the Town of Plymouth WPCA when a lateral sewer permit is issued to a Contractor, Developer, Drainlayer at the time a lateral pipe is installed from the main sewer line to some point at the side of the street, highway or similar location. The lateral pipe must be capped and intended for extension at some future time as part of a structured connection. In some instances, it may be necessary to use a Line Tap (instead of a lateral pipe) into the main sewer line. Permits shall be issued with proof of license, bond & insurance requirements according to section 2u of the Sewer Ordinance Concerning Sanitary Sewer Use for the Town of Plymouth, Litchfield County, Connecticut, dated 3-31-86.

**Sewer Connection Permit & Fee** – shall consist of two fees paid to the Town of Plymouth WPCA by the Contractor, Developer, Drainlayer of the applicable property at the time a sewer lateral is to be initially connected to that property (building, house, yard, etc) for the purpose of conveying sewage of any kind from said property to the sewer main. The first fee paid to the Town of Plymouth WPCA is for the permit. The second fee paid to the Town of Plymouth WPCA is for the initial connection. Permits shall be issued with proof of license, bond & insurance requirements according to section 2u of the Sewer Ordinance Concerning Sanitary Sewer Use for the Town of Plymouth, Litchfield County, Connecticut, dated 3-31-86.

**Sewer Re-Connection Permit and Fee** – may consist of two fees paid to the Town of Plymouth WPCA by the Contractor, Developer, Drainlayer of the applicable property at the time a sewer lateral is to be re-connected to that property (building, house, yard, etc) for the purpose of conveying sewage of any kind from said property to the sewer main. The first fee paid to the Town of Plymouth WPCA is for the permit and is required. The second fee (i.e., re-connection fee) paid to the Town of Plymouth WPCA only occurs whenever the length of a lateral connection increases or decreases from a point thirty (30) inches outside the outer wall of a building or structure during the re-connection phase. \*Sewer Re-connection Fee and Reconnection Permit Fee will be waived for Class III and Class IV food establishments complying with State of Connecticut, DEP Fats, Oils and Grease Program with the installation of a grease unit. Permits shall be issued with proof of license, bond & insurance requirements according to section 2u of the Sewer Ordinance Concerning Sanitary Sewer Use for the Town of Plymouth, Litchfield County, Connecticut, dated 3-31-86.

**Sewer Disconnection Permit Fee** – shall consist of a standalone fee paid to the Town of Plymouth WPCA by the Contractor, Developer, Drainlayer of the applicable property at the time a sewer lateral is to be disconnected/capped from that property (building, house, yard, etc) to the sewer main. Permits shall be issued with proof of license, bond & insurance requirements according to section 2u of the Sewer Ordinance Concerning Sanitary Sewer Use for the Town of Plymouth, Litchfield County, Connecticut, dated 3-31-86.

**Low Pressure Sewer Systems** – Permits will only be issues to a licensed State of Connecticut Plumber with a P1 or P2 (working under the employ of a P1) for installation, repair and maintenance of a low pressure sewer system

The rate of the permit and charges shall be established by the WPCA annually.
