The Plan will identify community development and affordable housing needs and set priorities for investment of federal grant funds to address them. These plans are required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the City and Consortium to receive federal money through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) programs.
