

OFFICIAL NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The City of West Bend, Wisconsin, will receive sealed bids for Contract 19-06, Water Utility Pavement Repairs at Various Locations, until **10:00 a.m., Tuesday, March 12, 2019**, at the office of the City Clerk, West Bend, Wisconsin, at which time and place the bids will be opened and read.

Significant types of work and approximate quantities include:

24 Inch Concrete Curb and Gutter	20	LF
4 Inch Concrete Sidewalk	400	SF
6 Inch Concrete Sidewalk	100	SF
6 Inch Concrete Driveway Approach	400	SF
Hot Mix Asphalt Pavement Patch	150	TON
Concrete Pavement Patch	100	SY
Landscape Restoration	75	SY

Contract 19-06 is a unit price contract. The estimated quantities as indicated above and in the contract Bid Proposal are inserted only for the purpose of determining the low bidder. The actual quantities utilized during construction may vary significantly from the quantities included in the bid proposal based on the number of repairs required by the Water Utility.

An Initial Repairs List of currently known repair locations is included within the project special provisions. All work included within the Initial Repairs List shall be completed no later than May 31, 2019.

A second list of repair locations will be provided to the Contractor at the project preconstruction meeting, to be held no later than April 26, 2019. All work included within this second list of repair locations shall be completed within 30 calendar days of notification of the additional repairs.

Thereafter, the Contractor will be provided with subsequent lists of repair locations on a monthly basis throughout the life of the contract, which shall remain open until October 31, 2019. All work included within subsequent repair lists shall be completed within 30 calendar days of notification of the additional repairs.

All bids shall be addressed to Stephanie Justmann, City Clerk, 1115 S. Main Street, West Bend, Wisconsin, 53095, with the name and address of the bidder and the contract for which the bid is submitted, clearly indicated on the outside of the envelope.

The City of West Bend, Wisconsin, reserves the right to reject any or all bids, subject to the provisions of Sections 62.15 and 66.0901 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the scheduled time of opening bids.

The letting of work described herein is subject to the provisions of Section 66.0901 Wisconsin Statutes, as it applies to work done under this contract.

No bid will be received unless accompanied by a Certified Check or a Bid Bond equal to 5% of the bid, payable to the City of West Bend, Wisconsin, as a guarantee that, if the bid is accepted, the successful bidder will execute and file the contract and payment and performance assurances, forming a part of the Specifications, within ten (10) days after the award of the contract. The payment and performance assurances must be for an amount at least equal to the contract price and must be in the form of a bond, an irrevocable letter of credit, or an escrow account acceptable to the City. In case the bidder fails to file such contract, performance bond, and payment bond, the amount of the check or bid bond shall be forfeited to the City as liquidated damages (Section 62.15(3) of Wisconsin Statutes).
