

The following summary of legislation passed by Dover City Council at its regular meeting the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 2017 is published once to comply with the Ohio Revised Code. A full copy of the text can be obtained or viewed at the Office of the Mayor of the City of Dover.

Emergency ordinance 8-17. An emergency ordinance to amend DCO 1143.03 to allow construction related businesses Third permitted uses in M-1 and M-2 districts and as conditional

uses in B-1 and B-2 districts. Emergency ordinance 11-17. Emergency ordinance to zone as B-2, the 46.833 acre parcel annexed into Dover and accepted by Dover City Council in ordinance 86-94 consistent with the use of those acres. Emergency ordinance 12-17. An emergency ordinance to amend DCO sections 1121.40, 1121.42, and enact DCO 1121.401 of the Dover Codified Ordinances. Emergency ordinance 14-17. An emergency ordinance accepting the annexation of the Dover Land Development property and the City of Dover property of approximately 9.730 acres into Dover as approved by the Tuscarawas County Commissioners and zoning the property R-4. Emergency ordinance 22-17. An emergency ordinance authorizing additional funding for the Speedway Sanitary Sewer Pump Station in an amount not to exceed \$4,600.00. The Clerk of Council will supply a copy of the complete text with a written request and payment of a fee of .10 cents per page.

Emergency resolution 12-17. An emergency resolution authorizing the police department and the City of Dover to dispose of certain property at public auction or sale. Emergency ordinance 20-17. An emergency ordinance amending Dover Codified Ordinance 1331.02(d) to clearly prohibit trucks, trailers and semi-trailers or job site trucks, trailers or semi-trailers to be used as advertising device at any location within the city unless it is utilized as a temporary vehicle necessary for an ongoing work project at that location. Emergency ordinance 21-17. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Service Director to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the installation of a 14 inch diameter water line from the railroad tracks at County Road 80 to the north approximately 1920 feet to the end of Deeds Drive, in an amount not to exceed \$261,000.00, including engineering. Ordinance 24-17. An emergency ordinance making supplemental appropriations and authorizing the transfer of funds to meet current obligations of the City of Dover and the departments therein. The Clerk of Council will supply a copy of the complete text with a written request and payment of a fee of .10 cents per page.
