

The following summary of legislation passed by Dover City Council at its regular meeting the 6th day of August 2018 is published once to comply with the Ohio Revised Code. A full copy of the text can be obtained or viewed at the Office of the Mayor of the City of Dover. Emergency ordinance 29-18. An emergency ordinance to rezone PPN 15-02044-000, 234 West Slingluff Avenue. Emergency ordinance 33-18. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Service Director to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the installation of the waterline from Bank Street to the light plant and to the pump house for \$113,000, including engineering. The Clerk of Council will supply a copy of the complete text with a written request and payment of a fee of .10 cents per page.

An emergency resolution to approve the Stark-Tuscarawas-Wayne Joint Waste Management District's Amended Draft Solid Waste Management Plan on file with the Service Director's office. Emergency ordinance 32-18. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee to apply for the Clean Ohio Recreational Trails Program funds for improvements for the Canal Dover Riverfront Area and other areas that would enhance the trails, access to the trails of the Canal Dover Park, and trails throughout Dover that will be designed to ultimately connect to the park and trails. Emergency ordinance 34-18. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Service Director to enter a contract for the installation of new traffic signals at Dublin Drive and Wooster Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$165,222.95, including engineering. Emergency ordinance 35-18. An emergency ordinance making supplemental appropriations and authorizing the transfer of funds to meet current obligations of the City of Dover and the departments therein. Emergency ordinance 36-18. An emergency ordinance to approve, adopt and enact the 2018 replacement pages to the codified ordinances and to declare an emergency.
