Ferguson Township Police Officer Wins International Award



The Ferguson Township [Police Department](#) is pleased to announce **Officer Travis Park** was the recipient of the international Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) Officer of the Year Award for his outstanding work regarding crisis intervention. Officer Park, a seven year veteran of the township police department, is the first Pennsylvania officer to receive a CIT award. CIT International is a non-profit membership organization which strives to develop crisis intervention team programs throughout the United States and abroad. Its membership is comprised of law enforcement personnel, mental health providers and advocates. Officer Park received his award in October at CIT International's annual conference held in Hartford, CT.

Whitehall Road Construction: The End is In Sight



Residents and travels of Whitehall Road will be pleased to read that both construction projects--one sponsored by PennDOT, the other sponsored by the township--are scheduled to be completed this month. PennDOT anticipates the work on Whitehall Road/University Drive between West College Avenue and South Atherton Street will be wrapped up by **November 22nd**. Regarding the township project, Whitehall Road between West College Avenue and Tadpole Road, as of this writing, the detour is expected to be removed on **November 26th**. However, residents should keep in mind construction work is weather dependent and that date may need to change. ***The township thanks residents and travelers for their patience and assistance during construction!***

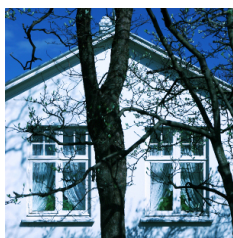
Township Meets with Home Owner and Condo Association Board Members

Township Development News: Stonebridge V



Stonebridge Planned Residential Development Phase V Senior Apartments will be located at [1680 Bristol Avenue](#) and is the last remaining vacant phase of the Stonebridge Planned Residential Development. The vacant lot is approximately 5.5 acres and is adjacent to the park at Stonebridge and immediately across Bristol Ave from the Stonebridge Little League fields. The project includes two proposed senior living apartment buildings with a total of 108 residential units. The project is proposed to be built in two separate phases. Parking for the project will require the construction of

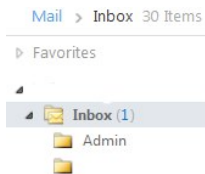
Township Offices Closed for Thanksgiving
