

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING

**AGENDA**

1. a. Motion was made by Mayor Pro-Tem Ellis and second by Council member Behrends to approve Resolution R-751-0219 Authorizing the submission of a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program Application to the Texas Department of Agriculture. Motion carried.
2. Council discussed a possible ordinance prohibiting recreational vehicles being parked on city streets. Staff was instructed to place the ordinance on the March agenda.
3. Administrative reports included:
  - a. The TML Region III meeting will be held on Thursday, March 7, 2019 at the Scottish Rite Learning Center of West Texas.
  - b. We will be having an election for City District #1 with two candidates on the ballot, Juan Chavez and Colt Ellis. We will cancel the District 2 election, Lupe Mendoza has filed for City District #2. The Hospital District will be cancelling their election as well. Allen Smyer has filed for District 2 and Dana Rasco for District 4. Ashley Turnbow and Kelly Kettner have filed for the two at large positions, but no one has filed for the special election to fill the unexpired term of Carroll Precure, however since this is a special election the filing deadline is March 4, 2019 at 5:00pm.
