

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING

1. Motion was made by Mayor Black and second by Councilmember McElroy to approve the minutes of the June 8, 2015 Council meeting. Motion carried.
2. Motion was made by Mayor Black and second by Councilmember Davis to approve the minutes of the June 15, 2015
3. Motion was made by Mayor Black and second by Mayor Pro Tem Ellis to instruct City Attorney Salter Elza to notify lessor Alan Harrison of Council's intent to terminate land leases for the Sanderosa Well Field and the North Well Field for default of contract unless payment is received within 15 days of date of letter. Motion carried.
4. Motion was made by Councilmember McElroy and second by Mayor Pro Tem Ellis to leave compensation for Council at the reduced minimum of water consumption. Motion carried. The vote was as follows:

5. Motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Ellis and second by Council member McElroy to approve receipts from the Muleshoe Ex Students Association in the amount of \$1440.06 of Hotel/Motel Tax Fund. Motion carried.
6. Motion was made by Mayor Black and second by Mayor Pro Tem Ellis to receive the Investment summary and Financial Statement for the quarter ending June 30, 2015. Motion carried.
7. Council instructed staff to contact Strategic Government Resources and ask that they attend the August Council meeting regarding the hiring process for the next city manager.
8. Administrative Reports included:
  - A. Another great July 4<sup>th</sup> celebration was enjoyed by everyone attending.
  - B. Movie in the Park will be held on Thursday, July 16<sup>th</sup>.
  - C. KCBD Channel 11 will be in Muleshoe on Wednesday, July 22 for the community profile.
  - D. The City of Muleshoe will host a Blood Drive on Wednesday, July 22 at City Hall.
  - E. The City held the annual swim party recently for Council, staff, employees and their families. A great time was had by all attending.
