

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF MULESHOE, TEXAS
Monday, June 10, 2019, 5:30 p.m. City Hall**

Mayor Black opened the meeting at 5:31 p.m.

1. a. Motion was made by Council member Behrends and second by Mayor Black to approve the minutes of the May 13, 2019 Public Hearing. Motion carried.
b. Motion was made by Mayor Black and second by Council member Mendoza to approve the minutes of the May 13, 2019 Council Meeting. Motion carried.
2. David Brunson introduced new Muleshoe Country Club Golf Pro, Mark England.
3. Motion was made by Council member Parker and second by Council member Behrends to approve up to a \$10.00 increase on green fees and to add a Jr. membership for new members 35 years and younger for \$75 monthly for the Muleshoe Country Club. Motion carried.
4. Motion was made by Mayor Black and second by Council member Behrends to accept the May 31, 2019 financials. Motion carried.

New Chamber Manager, Carina Reyes, was welcomed by the council. Carina advised council on upcoming 4th of July events and welcomed the community to come by the Chamber office and introduce yourself.

5. Administrative reports included:
 - a. The Muleshoe Water Park opened for the 2019 season on Tuesday, May 28, 2019. We had 221 admissions for the first day.
 - b. The Youth Fishing Day was held on Saturday, June 1st at Lake Muleshoe. 101 young fishermen were registered for the event.
 - c. Movie in the Park will be June 20th. We will be showing "The Wizard of Oz".
 - d. The TML Region III meeting will be held on June 20th at the Scottish Rite Learning Center in Lubbock. The program will be a workshop on "Generational Differences".
 - e. The library Summer Reading Program began Monday, June 3, 2019.
 - f. Staff reported that all RV's affected by the new RV Ordinance are now in compliance.

- g. Police cadets Jose Martinez and John Stiles will graduate from the SPAG Police academy on June 28th. A Police Badge Pinning ceremony for these cadets will be held on July 5th at the training facility.
- 6. Mayor and Council remarks included:
 - a. Council extended an invitation for all residents to come out and enjoy Movie in the Park.
 - b. Council and staff encouraged folks to be sure and come out to Mule Days & Kickin Nights on June 28th at the Muleshoe Country Club. Muleshoe Roadriders will be having an event in conjunction with Mule Days & Kickin Nights. “Dolly Shine” and “The Drake Hayes Band” will be performing that evening.
- 7. City Council and staff took a tour of the new projects that have recently been completed for the City of Muleshoe. Projects included a new stage at the park, new ground storage water tanks, new lift station and new paving project at the airport.
