1. a. Motion was made by Mayor Black and second by Mayor Pro-Tem Ellis to approve the minutes of the February 11, 2019 Council Meeting. Motion carried.

5. Motion was made by Mayor Pro-Tem Ellis and second by Council member Behrends to approve Ordinance O-511-0319 Prohibiting Parking and Storage of Recreational Vehicles on City Streets. Mayor Pro-Tem Ellis and Council members Behrends, Parker & Mendoza voted for and Mayor Black voted against. Motion carried.

 - c. The Airport Grant Construction Project will begin on March 18th. The project is contracted to take 88 days to complete. The Muleshoe Municipal Airport will be closed for the duration of the construction.
