1. Motion was made by Mayor Black and second by Mayor Pro-Tem Ellis to approve the minutes of the February 12, 2018 Council Meeting. Motion carried.
2. Motion was made by Council member Parker and second by Mayor Pro-Tem Ellis to cancel the May 5, 2018 general election for Mayor. Motion carried.
3. Motion was made by Mayor Pro-Tem Ellis and second by Council member Behrends for the appointment of election judges for the May 5, 2018 Special election. Motion carried.
4. Motion was made by Council member Behrends and second by Mayor Pro-Tem Ellis to award the bid for the Ground Storage Tanks to Dowtech Specialty Contractors, Inc for \$2,143,887. Motion carried.
5. Motion was made by Council member Parker and second by Mayor Pro-Tem Ellis to renew the contract with Leading EDG. Motion carried.
6. Motion was made by Mayor Black and second by Mayor Pro-Tem Ellis to approve the February 28, 2018 financials. Motion carried.
7. Administrative reports included:
 - a. The City held a wellness clinic on Tuesday, February 27, 2018. We had 39 employees and dependents participate.
 - b. The TML Region 3 quarterly meeting will be March 29th at the Scottish Rite Learning Center in Lubbock.
 - c. The City has received notification that Reach Broadband has been acquired by Financial Technologies, LLC dba AW Broadband of Amarillo, TX. The sale is expected to be effective April 1, 2018.
 - d. The Pilot's Lounge project at the Muleshoe Municipal Airport is complete.

- e. City of Muleshoe Police Department held an auction on Saturday, March 3, 2018 to sell abandoned and seized vehicles and miscellaneous equipment.
 - f. Ramon Sanchez, Kasey Coker and LeAnn Gallman participated in mock interviews at Muleshoe High School on March 2, 2018 to help prepare students for their future.
