

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION on Monday, June 18, 2012 at 7:00 PM with the following being present: Mayor Thomas and Commissioners Frazier, Haupt, Taylor and Holley, City Attorney Wilson and City Manager Howerton.

Commissioners Salik and Searcy and City Secretary Trull were unable to attend.

ALSO PRESENT: John Bridges, Chief Erisman, News Media and others.

INVOCATION was given by Commissioner Frazier.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE was led by Mayor Thomas.

MINUTES of the June 4th workshop were approved on motion by Commissioner Frazier, second by Commissioner Haupt with all members present voting AYE. Minutes of the June 4th regular meeting were approved on motion by Commissioner Frazier, second by Commissioner Taylor with all members voting AYE.

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ENNIS AND ELLIS COUNTY FOR ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF TAXES. Mr. Bridges, Ellis County Tax Assessor-Collector, was present to discuss an interlocal agreement for assessment and collection of taxes for the City of Ennis. As discussed in the workshop, Ellis County would perform all assessment and collection duties and functions imposed by law for the City of Ennis. The City of Ennis would pay the County up to one dollar (\$1.00) per parcel or account on their tax roll with no set up cost if the City of Ennis used Mr. Bridges' recommended law firm of Linebarger, Goggan, Blair and Sampson for delinquent tax issues. After discussion from the Commission, the interlocal agreement and the law firm of Linebarger, Goggan, Blair and Sampson were approved on motion by Commissioner Frazier, second by Commissioner Taylor with all members present voting AYE.
