

CITY OF ENNIS COMMISSION WORKSHOP

JUNE 16, 2014

6:00 P.M.

Mayor Pro-Tem Walker called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m. on June 16, 2014, in the City Commission Chambers of the City of Ennis Municipal Building, 115 W. Brown Street, Ennis, Texas 75119.

PRESENT: Mayor Pro-Tem Walker, Commissioners Salik, Hackney, and Holley, City Manager Ewings, City Attorney Wilson, Captain Anthony, and City Secretary Batchler. Mayor Thomas, Commissioners Frazier, and Searcy were not in attendance.

The proposed Street Maintenance and Crime Prevention District Sales Tax Elections were discussed. The Street Maintenance election must be called 78 days prior to the election of November 4<sup>th</sup>. This election must be called no later than August 4<sup>th</sup> to comply with the election code. The Crime Prevention District must be created and a temporary board appointed. The temporary board would call the election. The calling of the election must take place no later than August 18<sup>th</sup>. The city manager is to proceed with looking into the creation of the Crime Prevention District and is to bring the issue back to the Commission on July 7<sup>th</sup>.

The 2016 Street Maintenance Bond Program was discussed. Ten streets proposed for overlay were S. Preston, S. Gaines , Phillips, Linda, Louise , Hillcrest, Laru, Ennis Pkwy, Nesuda, and Willowglen which were removed from the 2014 Street Program at a cost of \$1,527,940. N. Sherman, S. Preston, Sleepy Hollow NE Main, Arnold, N. Sherman to Tyler to MLK were proposed for reconstruction at a cost of \$6,138,738.

Agenda Items: Resolution 14-06-02 adopting the City of Ennis Investment Policy was discussed.

Mayor Pro-Tem Walker adjourned the workshop at 6:48 p.m.
