The Public Works Department has an opening for a **Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator**. Shift and weekend work will be required. Subject to emergency call-outs as needed. Under the general supervision of the Wastewater Treatment Plant Manager. Responsible for skilled work in the operation of a regulated facility that has a direct effect on the health and well-being of the public.

Minimum qualifications and Education:

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- General knowledge of electricity, pumps, motors, basic mechanics.
- Basic understanding of mathematics and mathematical formulas.
- Basic computer skills.
- Obtain a Grade D Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator certification within 6 months of employment and Class C Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator certification within 18 months. A Class B certification will be required within 60 months.

Must Possess:

- Texas Class C Driver's License.
- Ability to move 100 pounds of various chemicals throughout system.

Summary of duties: Duties will include but are not limited to:

- Work independently within established requirements and follow oral and written instructions.
- Communicate clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing; prepare daily reports on plant operations.
- Assist the Coordinator with the pretreatment program.
- Possible contact with untreated wastewater.
- Collect samples and run process control tests to determine proper control and compliance with rules and regulations; monitor biomass and influent make-up.
- Keep buildings, work areas and grounds clean.
- Assist in maintenance of machinery and equipment; operate power and hand tools.
- Monitor and interpret Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) information and other process related gauges, meters, and scales.
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with supervisors and team members.
- Attend technical training schools and seminars to receive required certifications.
- Perform all duties in a safe and effective manner.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
