

Derby Police Commission

A meeting of the Derby Board of Police Commissioners was held on 13 JUN 16 at City Hall, 1 Elizabeth Street, Derby.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M. by Commissioner DeGennaro.

1. Pledge of Allegiance

2. Roll Call

Present were Commissioners DeGennaro, Bottone, and Mastrianni. Also present was Chief Narowski.

3. Public Portion

No one from the public was in attendance.

4. Adoption of Agenda

Commissioner DeGennaro motioned to adopt the agenda, Commissioner Mastrianni seconded and the motion carried.

5. Acceptance of Previous Meeting's Minutes

Commissioner Bottone motioned to accept the 09 MAY 16 minutes and Commissioner Mastrianni seconded. The motion carried without further discussion.

6. Old Business

No old business was discussed.

7. New Business

Chief Narowski updated the Board on a MPP that the city has filed against the union due to the fact that the union is continuing to file grievances on an issue that was already settled in arbitration.

Commissioner DeGennaro motioned to deny grievance # 16-01. Commissioner Bottone seconded and the motion carried with all in favor.

8. Department Reports

The Chief updated the commissioners on the department's patrol activity. He also reviewed the status of the police department's budget.

9. Communications

The Board was forwarded a letter from John Saccu thanking the department for supporting the Youth Bureau. The Board also reviewed a letter from the State of CT DOT advising them that the previous traffic pattern will be put back in place following the completion of their current construction.

10. Traffic Authority Business

There was no LTA report; however, the Board discussed road closures for the 4th of July fireworks and Derby Day events.

Commissioner DeGennaro motioned to close Elizabeth Street from Main Street to Fifth Street as well as small sections of Thompson Place and Minerva Street on July 1, 2016, or on the rain date, for the 4th of July Fireworks event. Commissioner Mastrianni seconded and the motion carried with all in favor.

Commissioner DeGennaro motioned to close Elizabeth Street from Main Street to Fifth Street on June 25, 2016, or on the rain date, for the Derby Day event. Commissioner Bottone seconded and the motion carried with all in favor.

11. Executive Session

Commissioner DeGennaro motioned to enter into executive session and invite Chief Narowski, Commissioner Bottone seconded and the motion carried at 6:35 PM.

The meeting reopened to the public at 6:43 PM.

Commissioner Mastrianni discussed a Federal judge ruling that recently occurred in California regarding “concealed carry” laws. Chief Narowski advised him that it had no effect on Connecticut law.

12. Adjournment

Commissioner Bottone motioned to adjourn. Commissioner Mastrianni seconded and the motion carried.
