

Derby Police Commission

A meeting of the Derby Board of Police Commissioners was held on 08 AUG 16 at City Hall, 1 Elizabeth Street, Derby.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M. by Commissioner DeGennaro.

1. Pledge of Allegiance

2. Roll Call

Present were Commissioners DeGennaro, Bottone, and Mastrianni. Also present were Chief Narowski and Deputy Chief Todd.

3. Public Portion

No one from the public was present.

4. Adoption of Agenda

Commissioner DeGennaro motioned to adopt the agenda, Commissioner Bottone seconded and the motion carried.

5. Acceptance of Previous Meeting's Minutes

Commissioner Bottone motioned to accept the 11 JUL 16 minutes and Commissioner Mastrianni seconded. The motion carried without further discussion.

6. Old Business

There was no old business discussed.

7. New Business

Chief Narowski forwarded the Board a MOA signed by Joseph Iacuone regarding his upcoming retirement.

8. Department Reports

Chief Narowski updated the commissioners on the department's patrol activity. There was nothing significant to report.

9. Communications

There were no communications.

10. Traffic Authority Business

Deputy Chief Todd reviewed the request from Ms. Hoase last month regarding her handicap parking space request. It was explained that they would be in violation of both Connecticut

statutes and building codes if they approved this request. The street needs to be wide enough to accommodate a 15' wide space and hashing as well as a flat surface. Cottage Street does not meet the requirements and therefore, it is recommended that the Board deny the request.

Commissioner DeGennaro motioned to deny the handicap space based on these findings. Commissioner Bottone seconded and the motion carried with all in favor.

DC Todd also updated the Board on a conversation he had with Connecticut DOT regarding a complaint made by Senator Crisco about his safety concerns near the recreation camp. As researched a couple years ago, neither the City nor the State has funding to install traffic controls in that area.

11. Executive Session

Commissioner DeGennaro motioned to enter into executive session and invite Chief Narowski and Deputy Chief Todd to discuss workers' compensation status. Commissioner Bottone seconded and the motion carried at 6:23 PM.

The meeting reopened to the public at 6:41PM.

12. Adjournment

Commissioner Bottone motioned to adjourn at 6:41 PM. Commissioner Mastrianni seconded and the motion carried.
