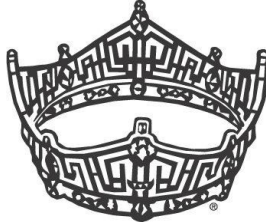

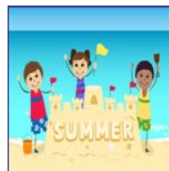
Got Backbone?+

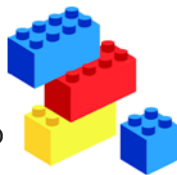

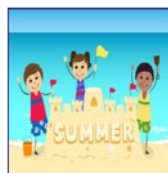

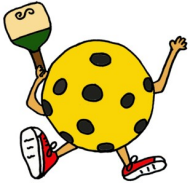
