2016 Bicycle Auction Information & Procedures

ALL ITEMS SOLD “AS IS WHERE IS”- NO RETURNS WILL BE ACCEPTED!

- Location: 1 Shelter Road (first left off of Tennessee Avenue, behind the OC Municipal Golf Course) **Remember to bring a hat, sunscreen and fluids.**
- Signup begins at **9:00** A.M. Upon arrival look for the clerks & cashiers.
- Please have your ID ready, which includes: a valid driver’s license, passport, casino, governmental or student ID.
- You will be given a numbered card to complete in order for you to fill in the required information. When completed you will return the card to the clerks with your ID to be verified **BEFORE** you can participate in the sale. You will be given a card with a number to be used to identify your bid during the auction. The auction begins at **10:00** A.M. & will take approximately 2 hrs depending on the number of items to be sold.
- All items are sold **“AS IS WHERE IS”**. Which means that all items are sold as they appear, with no warranties or claims made or implied by the City as to their working or overall condition. Once you have purchased an item it is yours!
- **NO RETURNS WILL BE ACCEPTED!**
- **If you see something you wish to bid on please hold up your card or hand until you are acknowledged by auctioneer.**
- Invoicing can take up to 25 minutes to complete & to be placed in the #’d box. Up to 12 items are recorded on each sale sheet, thus it takes time for your information to reach the cashiers for the final checkout.
- If you are **buying more than one item**, you do not need to come to the cashier after each and every item is purchased. **Please wait until the sale is over or that you have finished bidding for the day to settle with the cashiers.**
- Unfortunately, we cannot complete a transaction without the actual paper receipt in hand & a complete tally of all of your purchases from the clerks.
- Payment will be accepted by **check with ID, cash & checks only.** Exact change will make the transaction go faster. Thus we try to keep the sale prices in round numbers.
- It is important to keep your items in a central location or to bring someone with you to reduce the risk of your items being mixed with someone else’s or actually being stolen. Unfortunately, this has happened at past auctions.
- Please remember that you are responsible for your items once the bidding has concluded for that item. If the item is misplaced or stolen, you are still obligated to make payment for that item to the City.
- If you think that you see an item that belongs to you, please let us know & we will pull it from the auction until the matter can be resolved by the Police Department.
- Some bicycles appear to be newer, while others are well used and will require repairs to be made operational. Most bicycles are obtained by the Police Department as either abandoned or unclaimed property that the City has acquired during the course of the year.
