UPDATES FROM DEPARTMENTS ...

Finance

- The Town has collected \$1,326,889 (91.2%) of the total FY 2014 property taxes billed (\$1,454,922)
- Reminders for the past due taxes (\$128,905 or 8.8%) will be mailed the first week of July
- Currently 5 properties remain disconnected from water service for failure to pay their April utility billing

Planning

- Planning Commission Meeting:
 - Shops at College Park – Reduction in required parking spaces – ***Approved***
 - Bayside Health – Waiver in required loading spaces – ***Approved***
 - Beacon Hospitality – Conceptual Site Plan Review (78 room hotel) – ***Extensive Public Comment***

Police

- Significant Incident Reports distributed as received
- Circle cameras have been installed (see photo 1) – next will be training on their use
- Police Department open house hosted approximately 30 people

Public Works

- Additional 300 water meters have been ordered – delivery expected early next week
- A. C. Schulte's of Delaware has completed construction of both wells. Well characteristics (quantity/quality) are being analyzed for incorporation into final design (see photo 2)

Wastewater

- Hay cutting has resumed; hopefully dryer weather will return
- Through Thursday, June 20th, we had recorded 11” of rain for the month of June at the wastewater treatment facility
