**A. BILL BRADLEY – DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS**

At this time, the Town is averaging 600,000 gallons of water per day to supply the town. South Railroad Avenue plant and King Street Plant are alternating all three wells with an average run time of four (4) hours a day per well.

We are working with Del-DOT to have the Bedford and Market Streets repaved. We are evaluating the remaining water services that need to be replaced before the paving is done so we don't have to cut a new street again if possible.

With the rain we have had, we are able to keep up with grass cutting but week spraying and sweeper schedules have slowed,

With all the storm drainage work we have done lately, we had minor flooding with the last storm.


