# FY 2020 Budget Workshop

The Finance Staff and I have been working on the FY 2020 Budget – initial projections were distributed this evening and shows a deficit of \$1,708.811. We would like to schedule a workshop with the Mayor and Council to review the information, identify alternatives, and discuss potential solutions to address the projected deficit. Based on replies to the Doodle Poll, Tuesday, April 2, 2019 from 3:30 PM to 5:30 PM was the most convenient time – for anyone who cannot attend, a separate one on one meeting will be scheduled.

- Pedestrian Connectivity North Georgetown Elementary
  - The town will be meeting with DelDOT on Thursday, April 4 to review the project area, discuss alternatives, and develop a cost estimate.
- Technical Assistance Bike Trail Easement
  - A proposal from Simone Collins has been received and is under review by the Town Solicitor
