Per the Charter, Sections 2.5 and 2.1

At the annual meeting, held on the second regular meeting following the Annual Municipal Election, **the Town Council shall organize and elect a Vice-Mayor**, who shall hold office for the term of one (1) year or until his/her successor shall be duly elected.

The **Town Council shall likewise select a Secretary** from their own number to serve until the organization meeting after the next Annual Municipal Election.

Annually, **Town Council members shall sign an Affirmation of the Code of Ethics** as prescribed by the Town of Georgetown at the Council meeting in May each year when the Town Council elects the Secretary and Vice Mayor, as an acknowledgement of each Council member's continuing commitment to abide by the principles of this Code.

Additionally with my years of service on the Town Council, provides me with a unique knowledge of the vision and goals shared by the current Town Council.




I would like to be considered to serve as a member of the Georgetown Planning Commission.
