Town of Georgetown begins Comprehensive Plan Update

Public Invited to Provide Input on Future Development of Georgetown

Georgetown – The Town of Georgetown is embarking on a year-long process to update its current comprehensive plan that will guide the town over the next decade.

The “Plan Georgetown” campaign to develop the vision plan for the Town officially began at the August 24, 2016 Town Council meeting where a brief presentation was given, kicking off the project. Members of the Planning Commission were invited to attend as well.

A Community Outreach event will take place during the last Summer Concert of the year, Thursday, September 1 at 16 Mile Brewery, 413 S. Bedford Street, Georgetown, from 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM.

The outreach effort will include information on the comprehensive plan project and will coincide with the launch of the community survey. Georgetown’s Planning Consultants, KCI Technologies, Inc., will be present to discuss the project and gain valuable feedback from those in attendance.

A call for residents, property owners, business owners, employees, and visitors to the Town to contribute thoughts and ideas to the process is being solicited. The survey will close on November 1, but input will be solicited throughout the Comprehensive Planning process. Paper copies of the survey will be available at the Town Hall.
