**ORDINANCE 2017-05**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN,  
CHAPTER 230 THEREOF, ENTITLED ZONING**

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN IN COUNCIL MET AND  
HEREBY ORDAINS:

**Section 1.** Chapter 230, Article XVIII HD Historic District, § 230-135 Signs is hereby  
amended as follows:

**§ 230-135. Signs:**

~~No sign may be erected or altered without first submitting a drawing of the proposed sign depicting  
size, style, colors, lettering and location to the Planning Commission for review, comments,  
recommendations and changes. The Planning Commission may approve a sign if it is in character  
with the purposes and overall concept of the Historic District.~~

**Section 2.** Chapter 230, Article XXII Signs, § 230-173 Signs is hereby amended as follows:

§ 230-173. Signs permitted in HD Districts.

The following signs may be erected and maintained in an HD Historic District:

A. All signs must reflect the character of the district, ~~and receive approval from the Planning  
Commission.~~

**B. Sign design should be compatible with the Town of Georgetown Development Design  
Standards.**

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall become effective following its adoption by a majority vote of  
all members elected to the Town Council.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017 - 6**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE  
DELAWARE DIVISION OF SMALL BUSINESS,  
DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM  
DOWNTOWN DELAWARE COMMERCIAL  
DISTRICT AFFILIATE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Delaware Division of Small Business, Development and Tourism has established the Downtown Delaware Commercial District Affiliate Program to assist localities in developing public/private efforts to revitalize their downtown commercial areas, and

WHEREAS, interested Delaware cities, towns, and communities that are that are exploring downtown revitalization, those that may not be eligible for designation or those that do not wish to meet Main Street requirements may participate as an Affiliate, and

WHEREAS, Affiliate communities will have access to all Downtown Delaware training and limited on-site assistance, as resources permit, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown desires to participate in the Delaware Division of Small Business, Development and Tourism, Downtown Delaware Commercial District Affiliate Program and has completed the necessary application.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Town of Georgetown applies for selection to participate in the Delaware Division of Small Business, Development and Tourism, Downtown Delaware Commercial District Affiliate Program with the specific goal of economically revitalizing the designated downtown district within the context of historic preservation using the Main Street Approach as a model;

**SECTION 2.** The Town of Georgetown recognizes that the Main Street model is considered one of many economic and community development tools used by a locality and that successful downtown revitalization requires an on-going commitment, continuous attention and a full public-private partnership. Thus the Town has full intent to actively support and implement the initiatives developed as a result of Commercial District Affiliate status, resources permitting.

**SECTION 3.** The Town of Georgetown understands that participation as an Delaware Division of Small Business, Development and Tourism, Downtown Delaware Commercial District Affiliate Program does not guarantee selection as a Designated Main Street Community, and that the Town will be eligible to receive Affiliate Community services from Downtown Delaware as long as the requirements stated in the Program Guidelines are met.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its approval by Council.

**ADOPTED** by a majority vote of the Town Council of The Town of Georgetown this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August, 2017.
