- Bunker refurbishments on holes 13 & 14 that includes a higher quality sand expected to receive positive feedback.

- The refurbishment of the drainage ditch between holes 15 and 16 that enhances the appearance of the course and outlines a hazard that may now offer multiple opportunities to a player
